Requirements:

1. Applicant must be of Haitian descent.
2. Applicant must be graduating from high school in the spring of 2019.
3. Applicants must show proof that they have been accepted at an accredited college or university for fall 2019.
4. Applicant must have earned a minimum 3.2 GPA.
5. Applicant must have completed 100 hours of volunteer hours preferably in the Haitian community by April 1, 2019.
6. Applicant should not have any history of criminal convictions.
7. Applicant must have a recommendation letter from a family or friend who is a current HAFTB member (member must be in good standing with dues paid).
8. Applicant shall submit a letter of recommendation from a teacher or counselor.
9. Applicant must be present at the HAFTB meeting on May 18, 2019.

Write a unified and coherent essay in which you evaluate Roumain’s perspectives on the importance of Education.

In your essay, be sure to:

- . Analyze and evaluate the perspective given (from the book)
- . State and develop your own perspective on the issue
- . Explain the relationship between your own perspective and the one given.
